



## **Brett BeGole**

### **General Manager, Global Locomotive Operations GE Transportation**

Brett BeGole is General Manager of Global Locomotive Operations at GE Transportation.

Brett joined GE in 1988 on the Operations Management Leadership Program. After completing the leadership program, he joined GE's Corporate Initiatives Group (CIG) in Fairfield, Connecticut, where he led business teams to develop new products.

In 1993, Brett became Manager of Product Planning at GE Transportation where he helped introduce AC technology locomotives. Brett moved to GE Energy in the Reuter Stokes group as Vice President of Business Development and Sales. Through several acquisitions, Reuter Stokes successfully diversified from nuclear power products into environmental sensors and oil and gas product lines.

At GE Lighting, Brett was President of GE Home Electric Products, a business unit providing consumer electrical devices and lighting fixtures to major U.S. retailers. He was then promoted to GE Aviation in the role as General Manager of Business Development to lead acquisitions and joint venture strategy for the \$18B aircraft engines division.

In February 2006, he was named to lead GE Transportation's Global Locomotive Group where he is responsible for commercial proposals, pricing and product management of the global locomotive product lines, including the Evolution® Series locomotive, GE's most technologically advanced, fuel-efficient and eco-friendly diesel-electric locomotive to-date.

Brett holds a Bachelor's of Mechanical Engineering from Michigan State University and an MBA from Ohio State University. He also studied engineering at Rhineland-Westphalian Technical University (RWTH) in Aachen, Germany.
